

FORD Ranger Rear Housing Installation <u>Guide</u>

Approx Fit Time- 4-6hrs

Parts required- 2 x Axle Seals Part n.o- AB391177AA or

AB Z1S177A



Removal of Factory Housing

- 1. Remove wheels
- 2. Clamp Brake Lines
- 3. Disconnect Handbrake lines from underbody
 - 4. Disconnect handbrake from brake drums
 - 5. Remove Diff Breather Hose
- 6. Remove Hydralic Brake lines/ABS Sensors, and brake line clips
- 7. Remove diff drain plug and filler plug, and drain oil from pumpkin
 - 8. Remove major brake bracket from top of pumpkin
 - 9. Remove brake line in back of the brake drum
 - 10. Remove 4 nuts from rear of wheel hubs
 - 11.Remove Hub and axle
- 12. Remove Inner Plastic sleeve (Keep this to reuse in DWIZ housing)

13.Refit Drain plug

14.Remove Diff Lock

15. Remove tailshaft bolts

16. Remove Centre diff bolts (Bolts only at this stage- Leave studs)

17. Support Centre with Jack

18. Remove Centre diff studs nuts

19. Remove Centre (Careful-These are heavy)

20. Support diff housing with jack stand

21. Remove Lower sway bar bracket

22.Remove lower shock bolts

23.Remove UBolts

24. Remove Housing from vehicle

Installation of Dwiz Diff Housing

- 1. Remove studs from Factory housing and fit to Dwiz Housing (Use Locite)
 - 2. Lift housing back into vehicle and support with jack stand
 - 3. Refit Ubolts and Dwiz Top Plate with Bump stop
 - 4. Refit sway bar
 - 5. Clean the machined surfaces with Brake cleaner
 - 6. Run RTV sealant around centre and locite the bolts and studs
- 7. Fit Centre into housing ensuring centre is dead straight on studs
 - 8. Refit Diff breather line
 - Reconnect Diff Lock10.Refit diff plug
 - 11. Refit major brake bracket on pumpkin
 - 12.Refit Brake bracketry
 - 13.Cut excess length off ubolts
 - **14.Retorque Ubolt**
- 15.Fit inner axle seal (Use a flat surface seal driver, with a properly weighted hammer, ensuring that the seal is driven in evenly until it is home)
- 16.Refit axles and hubs (Fit brake line in place before tightening bolts)
 17.Tighten the 4 wheel hub nuts on the rear
 - 18. Refit brake line in to the back of the wheel drum

19.Refit ABS Sensor

20. Refit handbrake bracketry

21.Fill with approx. 3.4lts of manufacture recommended Diff oil 22.Bleed brakes

Note- ensure you retorque suspension bolts after 100km of driving
